

Introduction

Basically, the statistical information on judicial affairs covers the judicial system, types of crimes and offences committed in a year, and the number and characteristics of offenders for each type as well as juvenile delinquency, number of victims of crimes, sentences issued for the convicted, etc. However, because of some problems in compiling or disseminating data, this chapter contains only data on the judicial system, offences, robberies, accidents, and drugs seized. Below you will find a brief record of the production of data in these areas.

Because of the importance of data collection on different judicial areas, related statistics were compiled by implementing surveys on marriage in the year 1336, crimes and offences (including crime suspects and the convicted) in the year 1344, and divorce, suicide, and family support (only for Tehran) in the year 1346.

In the month of Tir of the year 1373, to make courts of justice more integrated, the new structure of general courts and revolutionary courts replaced several types of traditional courts and public prosecutor's offices.

Data collection on road accidents began in the year 1336 by the Highway Patrol under the supervision of the Police Department, and from the year 1346 through the year 1369, the Gendarmerie Highway Police was tasked with this responsibility.

Since the year 1370, when three forces of the Islamic Revolution Committee, the Police Department, and Gendarmerie were incorporated into one force as the Police of the I.R. of Iran, the data on road accidents (called intra-city accidents) and car crashes in urban areas (called inter-city accidents) have been collected and released by the new organization.

Due to the importance of presenting statistics on

comprehensive control of drugs and psychedelics in specialized fields, including controlling the supply of drugs, treatment and decreasing the damages, social support, and primary prevention of addiction, a separate part of this chapter is considered for presenting statistics and information on plans and activities of the Drug Control Headquarters.

Definitions and concepts

General court: This refers to a court that is established to proceed with and resolve all claims and cases (except for matters assigned to other courts by law and not included within the scope of this law) with general legal, family, criminal court II, and juvenile jurisdictions in each jurisdiction (either from Shahrestans (sub-provinces) or districts).

Revolutionary court: This refers to a court established in the capital of Ostans (provinces) or other areas by recognition of the Head of Judiciary to proceed with the following offences and crimes.

a. All offenses against the national and international security of the country; waging war against God (Moharebeh) or corruption on the earth; rebellion (baghi); collusion and unlawful gathering against the Islamic Republic of Iran; and armed attempts, arson, destruction, or damage of public properties to combat the Islamic government.

b. Insult to the Founder of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the Supreme Leader.

c. All crimes relating to narcotics, methamphetamines, and their raw prerequisite materials; smuggling arms, ammunition, and items; and materials under control and supervision.

d. Other cases under the jurisdiction of this court by special laws.

Appeal court: This is a court established in the capitals of Ostans (provinces) to deal with the appeals of all primary court decisions (except for the cases under the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court).

Public and Revolutionary Prosecutor's Office:

This refers to a unit that is formed under the jurisdiction of the justice departments of the Shahrestans (sub-provinces) and is responsible for detecting crime, prosecuting the person accused of a crime, filing a lawsuit in terms of divine rights, protecting public rights and Islamic limits, executing the court's decree, and dealing with non-litigious matters according to legal rules (Article 3 of the Law on the Establishment of Public and Revolutionary Courts).

Council for Dispute Settlement: This refers to a quasi-judicial institution that has been established to solve disputes, make peace, and reconcile between natural and legal persons, in consideration of the limits of jurisdiction outlined in the Council for Dispute Settlement Law (Article 1 of Council for Dispute Settlement of the year 1387). The establishment of this council aims to reduce the number of court visits and foster individual partnerships.

Car accident: It refers to the overturning or collision of two or more vehicles against each other, objects, pedestrians, or animals, which result in physical damage, injury, or death.

Intra-city accident: It refers to car crashes on roads (outside of urban areas).

Inter-city accident: This term refers to car crashes that occur within urban areas.

Accidents resulting in harm or loss. This refers to the overturning or collision of two or more vehicles against each other, pedestrians, or other objects, which leads to physical damage.

Road accidents with injuries: This refers to the overturning or collision of two or more vehicles, pedestrians, or other objects, resulting in injuries to one or more individuals.

Road accidents resulting in fatalities: This refers to incidents where two or more vehicles collide or overturn, causing the death of individuals involved, including pedestrians or other objects.

Persons injured in road accidents: This refers to individuals injured in road accidents.

Persons killed in road accidents: It refers to the individuals who have died as a result of road accidents.

Opioids: This refers to a group of natural or synthetic chemical compounds that activate the opioid receptors in the brain and affect the central nervous system, thereby reducing pain sensations in the body. It should be noted that prolonged use of these substances can lead to addiction.

Psychoactive substances: It refers to a class of drugs that alter mood and affect the brain, nervous system, cognition, and perception of an individual.

Selected information

In the year 1402, the Iranian judicial system saw an increase in its operational capacity. General courts had 4,074 active branches, appeal courts had 720, revolutionary courts 262, and criminal courts 133. These figures represent an increase in operational branches compared to the preceding year by 5.6%, 8.4%, 4.4%, and 0.8% respectively. In 1402, the Police Department of the I.R. of Iran reported 219,655 robberies from private buildings and 16,719 from government buildings. These numbers represent a decrease of 10.0% and 10.6%, respectively, compared to the previous year. Additionally, the department registered 108,129 house robberies, 26,072 shop robberies, 77,291 car thefts, and 94,504 motorbike thefts in 1402. These specific categories also saw a decline from the preceding year, with decreases of 18.9%, 25.8%, 9.2%, and 2.2% respectively.

In the year 1402, the number of intra-city car accidents reached 1,941,153 cases, representing a 12.0% increase compared to the previous year. It's noteworthy that 0.2% of these accidents resulted in fatalities, 11.7% led to injuries, and 88.1% caused property damage. Similarly, inter-city accidents also saw a 7.6% increase compared to the previous year, totaling 415,648 cases. Of this number, 3.0% of accidents resulted in fatalities, 23.8% led to injuries, and 73.2% caused property damage. Furthermore, it's worth mentioning that the number of people killed in intra-city accidents in the year 1402 increased by 10.3% compared to the previous year, while the number of people killed in inter-city accidents increased by 2.7%.

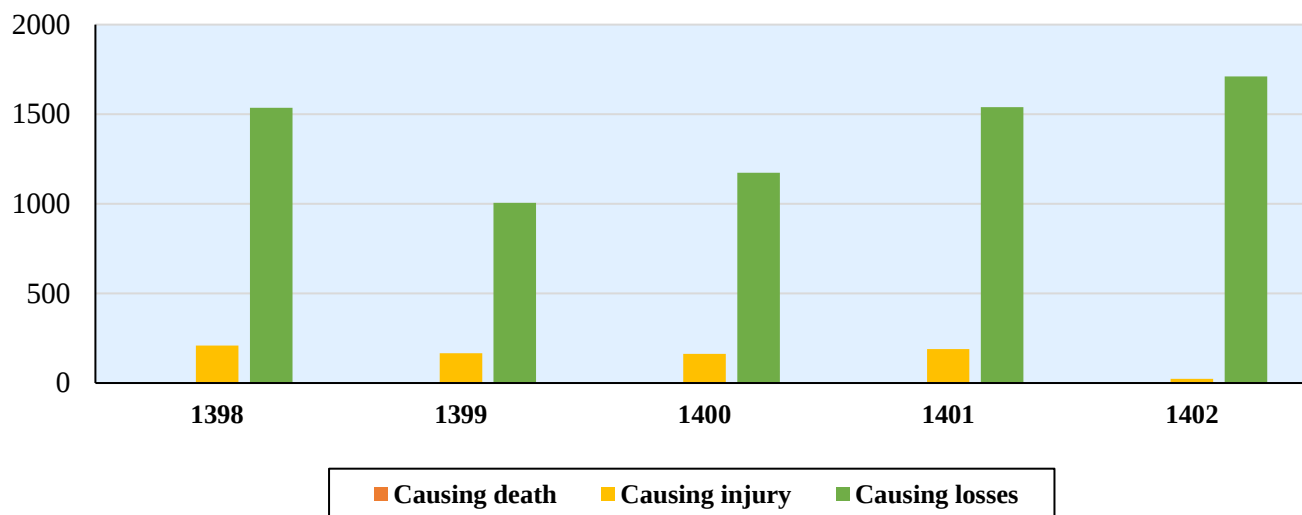

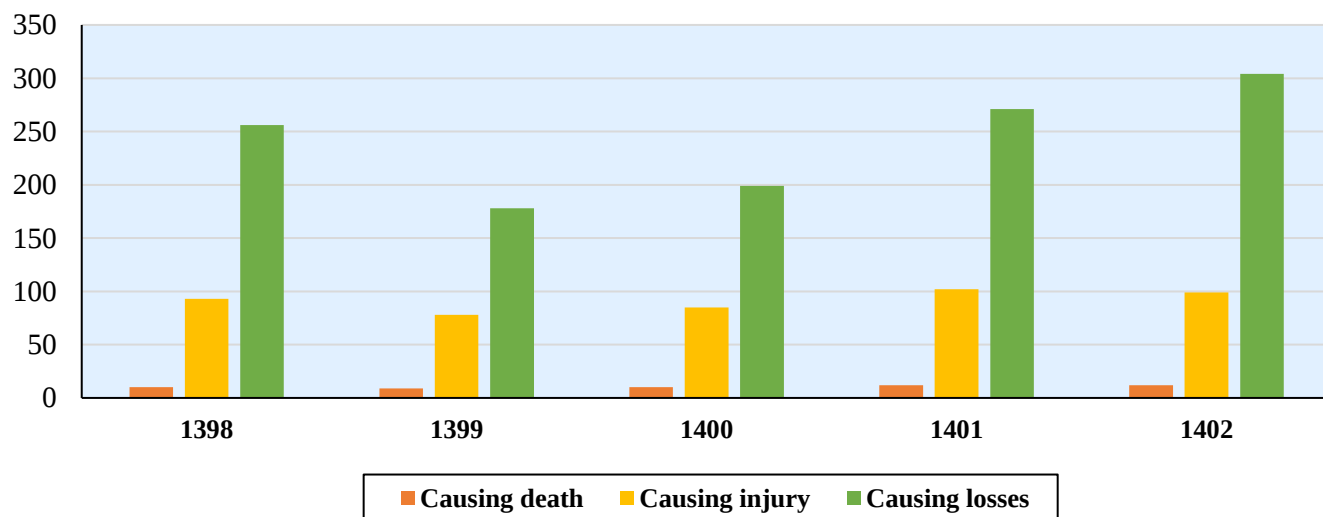
