Preface

The Statistical Yearbook of Iran contains the latest statistical information available on economic, social, cultural, and political areas of the country to meet the statistical data needs of decision-makers, planners, and researchers, as well as all other interested users. The Yearbook has been released regularly since the year 1345.

The major sources of the Yearbook include: (a) the results of censuses and sample surveys conducted by the Statistical Centre of Iran (SCI), (b) administrative registers, and (c) the results of surveys conducted by other government organizations. Since the Population and Housing Census and also some other censuses and surveys conducted by the SCI or other organizations are not taken at regular intervals, some of the Yearbook's statistical items are not available annually and continuously.

In order to make timely provision of important statistical information to meet the statistical needs of users and reduce their visit to various organizations producing statistics, the SCI has attempted to prepare, compile and release different statistical publications in a timely manner, including the National Statistical Yearbook, and also developed the National Statistical Information Database.

The publications' information database of the Statistical Centre of Iran, as one of the components of the National Statistical Information Database, has been accessed on the web since the year 1381 through the National Statistical Portal at www.amar.org.ir. In this database, which is continuously provided with the statistical information, quick and easy access is provided to the information of the publications' tables of the SCI by using extensive search facilities, and currently, the information related to the National Statistical Yearbook 1398, is available to users in the section of statistical yearbook system of the National Portal of Statistics.

In addition to the mentioned database, the information of the National Statistical Yearbook for the years 1387 to 1395 is accessible through the electronic system of this publication with various capabilities at http://salnameh.sci.org.ir.

The 1398 Statistical Yearbook of Iran is released both in Persian and English of which the e-copy is also available to the users. In addition, .At the same time with the release of the statistical yearbook of the country, the statistical yearbooks of 31 Ostans (provinces) are prepared and published by the Management and Planning Organization of the Ostans with similar format under the supervision of the Statistical Center of Iran.

Before going through the chapters, users are recommended to study the introductions which take in the definitions and concepts concerned and the subject-matter coverage of the statistical items, as important points needed for the statistics of each Chapter, carefully. Furthermore, they provide readers with justifications for the unavailability of some timely data or the exclusion of some statistical items.

It is noteworthy that the yearbook starts with selected information of all chapters and the beginning of every chapter includes selected information of that chapter. In or der to have a general view of all information presented in the Yearbook, reading of these parts is recommended.

Particular thanks and appreciation are extended to all the Director-Generals of Statistics and Information Offices of the ministries, organizations, and the Islamic Revolution Institutions as well as all their colleagues who helped us in this great job. Their generous and valuable assistance contributed a lot to the preparation of the Yearbook. We hope to enjoy their cooperation and contribution continuously for enhancing the yearbook quantitatively and qualitatively. Special thanks should go to my colleagues in the Statistical Centre of Iran who contributed to the preparation and production of this publication.
